

Addition Fact Families

Learning math facts using addition fact families

Below are the problems involving addition facts. The addition fact family may be consisting of three numbers or two numbers. Based on that, there can be four addition facts or two addition facts. To guide you, first two problems are done as an example. In rest of the problems the numbers are given, you need to write the addition fact family for those numbers.

1) 9, 3 and 12

Facts family below

$$3 + 9 = 12$$

$$9 + 3 = 12$$

$$12 - 3 = 9$$

$$12 - 9 = 3$$

2) 9, 4 and 13

Only 2 facts in the family

$$9 + 4 = 13$$

$$4 + 9 = 13$$

$$13 - 9 = 4$$

$$13 - 4 = 9$$

3) 0 and 7

4) 5, 8 and 13

5) 2, 10 and 12

6) 2, 7 and 9

7) 9, 8 and 17

8) 8, 2 and 10

9) 7, 5 and 12

10) 5, 9 and 14

11) 8, 10 and 18

12) 3, 8 and 11
